WMAT Secondary 2025 GCSE Results

- ♦ **In the top 0.1% of schools** for progress nationally
- ♦ Progress 8 score of **+1.72, the 4th highest in the country** compared to 2024 data
- ♦ In 2025, **46%** of our Year 11 students achieved **12 or more GCSEs, only 0.01% of students nationally achieved this**
- ♦ Our students achieved **over 1600** top grades **9 - 7**

Year 13 Outcomes:

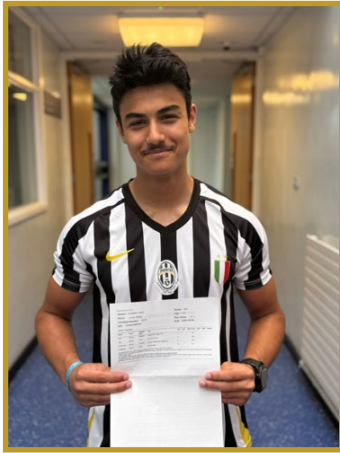
- ♦ **42%** of grades were awarded at **A–A***, including 51 A*s and 97 As (vs 28.2% nationally) – **our best results ever!**
- ♦ **88%** of grades were at **A–C***, exceeding national outcomes by more than 10%.
- ♦ **100%** of students achieved **at least an A*–E grade**
- ♦ **26** students achieved **at least 3 A grades**
- ♦ Congratulations to the **5** students who achieved **3 or 4 A* grades**
